



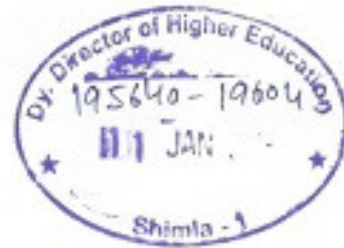

Sir/Madam,

In continuation to letter no. 6593-6647 NO. HPSES-Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan-(H.O) swyamsidham, dated on 26/11/2018 issued by Secretary Education, you are again requested to take timely steps to improve the performance of the students in National/State surveys and Board Examinations. In this regard a meeting was held in the District Bilaspur for one day, dated on 28th November, 2018 under the chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner of the District to improve quality (copy of proceeding attached).

All the participants came to the conclusion that schools heads having ICT, will facilitate the students to use ICT labs to tap effective e-content with participation of the subject teachers. You are also requested to adopt following steps:

1. Make maximum utilisation of computer labs and on-line resources.
2. Identify the Science students of 10th and 10+2 classes(2 to 5 per board class),having potential to get good marks in HP Board Exams and also desire to appear into the entrance examinations of JEE and NEET. The schools will ensure the filling up of on-line entrance forms of the students as specified in letter no.732757 dated on 26-11-2018.
3. At least for two hours, they will give them the exposure to go through the e-material uploaded on the gnsahimachal.nic.in at RESOURCE MATERIAL and ON-LINE COMPETITIVE TEST MODULE TABs, as it has been prepared keeping in view board and competitive exams. They will use open end resources also.
4. Follow up the performance of students and provide full support to the students of the subject teachers to understand the Basic and Advanced level Notes and to solve the problems given in the four levels of question papers. The results of the identified students in BOARD RESULTS in 2018-19 batches will also be recorded for better improvement of the e-content.
5. The Best performers will also be awarded.
